## **Covid-19 Visitor Guidance**



## Welcome to Pembroke College.

We are very conscious of the measures required to continue to ensure the safety and security of our community and reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19.

Our current approach is focused on ensuring our colleagues and guests are as comfortable as possible whilst we deliver your event experience.

- Please do not enter the College if you are currently experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
- If you have been fully vaccinated in the UK or Ireland, or are exempt from self-isolation for other reasons, and are notified that you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please notify your Event Organiser. If you are not yet onsite, we request you take a PCR test before your arrival, or if you are notified whilst onsite, please take a PCR test as soon as possible.
- If you are not fully vaccinated in the UK or Ireland and are not exempt from self-isolation for other reasons, and have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, you may have to self-isolate according to UK Government guidance. If you are already onsite please notify your Event Organiser who will discuss the options with Pembroke College.
- If you are a UK resident and develop COVID-19 symptoms whilst onsite at an event, please return home safely and directly if you are able to, and follow Government guidance on taking a PCR test and selfisolating. If you are too unwell or unable to travel safely, please self-isolate in your College accommodation, and notify your Event Organiser who will discuss the options with Pembroke College.
- If you are an overseas resident and develop COVID-19 symptoms whilst onsite at an event, please self-isolate in your College accommodation, book a PCR test and notify your Event Organiser who will liaise with Pembroke regarding the options.
- **NHS Track and Trace** is available at the Lodge entrance should you wish to check in on arrival.
- We encourage continued and frequent sanitation whilst in the venue, using the sanitiser and hand washing facilities available. We provide anti-bacterial wipes in all meeting rooms – you can use these to wipe down your immediate area (tables, chairs etc) and any shared equipment before and after use.
- We recommend making use of all **natural ventilation** (by opening windows, doors and vents), in enclosed spaces.
- Face coverings are encouraged but optional.

For your reassurance we operate with the highest possible cleanliness standards and continue to adapt our procedures to keep us all safe.

If in doubt please follow UK Government guidance, speak to your Event Organiser or a member of College staff.
